RE: FLOODS AND FIRES

National Parks and Wildlife Service staff are busy working to reopen popular spots in our national parks after this terrible fire season and subsequent flooding event. We are focusing on reopening popular roads and facilities. Our priority is to make all our facilities safe and serviceable for visitors before they are opened.

At the time of this bulletin:

- Eurobodalla National Park is open, except Brou Lake Campground; please refer to the website for further info re: safety warning on the beaches.
- Mimosa Rocks National Park is due to open on Friday 21.02.2020. Please refer to the website for further information.
- Montague Island Nature Reserve has been operational for some weeks.
- Deua, Monga, Gulaga, Kooraban, Biamanga, and Wadbilliga National Parks and Badja Swamps Nature Reserve and Murrah Flora Reserve remain closed due to extensive fire and flood damage to roads, bridges and public facilities and the potential for further tree fall.
