GULAGA NATIONAL PARK & MIMOSA ROCKS NATIONAL PARK

DROMEDARY TRAIL - GULAGA NATIONAL PARK – CLOSED

ARAGUNNU – NORTH CAMP– MIMOSA ROCKS NATIONAL PARK – CLOSED

ROAD WORKS - MIMOSA ROCKS NATIONAL PARK

Due recent days of heavy rainfall and high wind in the Tilba area we are advising the public that the Dromedary Trail leading into Gulaga National Park is closed until further notice.

The trail surfaces are expected to be wet and slippery and there may be a significant amount of timber down across the trail.

Visitors or locals to the area <u>should not attempt</u> to access Gulaga National Park by 4wd via the Dromedary Trail as it maybe impassable in parts and very susceptible damage from vehicles at this time.

The heavy rain and strong winds have caused damage to campground facilities at Aragunnu in Mimosa Rocks National Park and for this reason part of the campground will be closed until further notice.

Road works continue on all public access roads in Mimosa Rocks National Parks until Christmas. Local closures to these roads will occur intermittently during works.
