RE: ACCESS UPDATE - DEUA AND MONGA NATIONAL PARKS

Due to recent floods and ongoing wet weather we are advising the public that Bendethera Camping Area is still <u>**CLOSED**</u> and may remain closed over the coming Christmas holiday period. High water levels in the river have made it impossible for staff to make an assessment on the safety of the 3 crossings in the valley.

Merricumbene, Dry Creek and Oulla Creek Fire Trails are still <u>CLOSED</u> and will remain closed until inspections can be carried out by NPWS staff. Dry Creek Camping Area will also remain <u>CLOSED</u> until further notice.
